EVALUATION AND TALL TALES/HUMOROUS/INTERNATIONAL SPEECH CONTESTS**CONTEST MASTER**

(Announce)

“Speech contests are an important part of the Toastmasters educational program.”

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"Speech contests provide an opportunity for speakers to gain contest experience, and to recognize the best speakers as an encouragement to everyone."

"Contests also provide an opportunity to learn by observing the more proficient speakers who have benefited from their Toastmasters training."

"We will have two contests: The Evaluation and (***Tall Tales/Humorous/International***)

For our Evaluation Contest, all contestants will evaluate the same speech presented by our Featured Speaker. After the speech, contestants will be moved to a separate breakout room, where they will have five minutes to complete their notes. After five minutes, they will be asked to put down their writing utensils and ensure their hands are visible to the camera throughout the waiting period until it is their turn to compete. They will be asked to keep both camera and microphones on through-out the time they are in the breakout session.

The contestants will return to the main room one at a time, in speaking order, to present their evaluation, and will be able to utilize their notes once they return to the main room. Once they have given their evaluation, they may remain in the room.

(TALL TALES/HUMOROUS/INTERNATIONAL) SPEECH CONTEST

CONTEST MASTER

Call meeting back to order and get the energy back up!

Deliver any special remarks

(Announce)

"Please give your full attention to the contestants while they are speaking. There will be a minute of silence between each speaker to allow the judges to mark their ballots, and indefinite silence after all

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speakers to allow the judges to tally their ballots and the ballot counters to collect all ballots.

"At this time, please check that your microphone is on mute, video hidden and all cell phones or other electronic noisemakers are turned off or to silent, so that they will not distract the speakers. Please refrain from Zoom chatting, texting or status updating during the contests.

"Recording is not permitted without the prior written permission of the contestants. Further, please do not create screenshot photos or audio recordings of any presentation today or post them on any Social Media platform without obtaining the speaker's permission."

When all ballots are collected, the Chief Judge will let you know.

CONTEST MASTER

MEET THE CONTESTANTS

(Announce)

Lead applause as the contestants return to the audience's focus.

RECOGNITION OF HELPERS:

Turn the focus to the Contest Chair by calling him or her by name and thanking them.

Lead Applause

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Thank the judges for judging. BUT DO NOT ask the judges to introduce themselves or unmute their microphones. *The current rule requires judges to remain anonymous.*

Lead Applause

If the Chief Judge has returned, turn the focus on him or her by introducing him or her by name and thanking him or her.

Thank the contest helpers: Timers, Sergeants-at-Arms, Ballot Counters, and Registration. *Their microphones should remain muted.*

Lead Applause

- Chief Judge lets Contest Master the voting is complete.

- Sr. SAA moves the Contest Chair and myself to breakout room with Chief Judge

District Representative

Contest Chair can move to Slide 12.

Turn the focus to the District Representative for DISTRICT announcements

"Now let's hear from [Educational level and Name] about District announcements."

Lead applause.

District Rep unmutes microphone and makes announcements

Representative returns control to Contest Master to winners.

Note: Please allow time for the Contest Master to collect info. Stall if needed.

- In break out room, Contest Chair updates slides 14-16 and 18-20.

- Contest Masters updates printed winners sheet from the Chief Judge.

- When they are complete, Sr. SAA moves everyone back over to the contest room.

(Lead applause)

CONTEST MASTER

PRESENTING AWARDS

(Announce)

"And now the moment we have all been waiting for: the announcement of the winners. . ."

Announce any disqualifications, then winners, EXACTLY according to the list provided by the Chief Judge.

- *In contests with three or more contestants, announce third, second, and first place.*
- *In contests with two contestants, announce only second and first place.*

Contest Chair can move to Slide 21.

No more announcements or comments will follow announcement of winners.

(Announce)

"This contest is adjourned!"

"We will now have a debriefing with the core team. Everyone else, please log off at this time. Again, thank you for attending."
