Basis of action:

Each year, the District must review, and amend, if needed, the alignment of clubs, Areas, and Divisions within its boundaries.

The Alignment Committee considered a plan that serves clubs in the most effective way and meets the requirements outlined in: District Administrative Bylaws, Article XI (d) Policy and Protocol, Protocol 7.0:

Requirements:

- Club Assignments: The best interests of the clubs and District are taken into consideration when assigning clubs to Areas.
- Areas consist of four (4) to six (6) clubs as of July 1, of which a minimum of four (4) must be in good standing.
- District 50 assigned clubs to Areas based upon:
 - a. Geographic proximity to other clubs
 - b. The ability of an Area Director to effectively provide service, without requiring the clubs to change how meetings are conducted to accommodate an Area Director visit
 - c. Club size and strength (e.g., paid, active, disbanding)
 - d. Prospective clubs and expected growth.
- Divisions have a minimum of four (4) areas. It was important for the committee to consider club growth as well as club loss when contemplating the alignment. District 50 Alignment Committee chose additional criteria for alignment: distance to travel to district events (contests, training) - balanced numbers of members in clubs and areas - quality of clubs – combination of weak and strong clubs in one area - support for weak clubs. The optimum number of clubs in the area is 4 to 5.

Alignment proposal for year 2026/2027.

The data presented below, show the composition of a new division for D-50, the absorption of the Toastmasters of Lincoln Parish Club from D-68; which will be placed in Division E, Area 12. The Bossier Club, currently in Div E, Area 12, is being moved into Div E, Area 11. Except for these noted changes, all existing divisions, areas, and clubs remain intact.

(New Division): Division Name: "OZARK"

Listed here are the 25 Central Arkansas Clubs that are transitioning from D-43 into D-50, forming this new Division with "5" Areas, effective July 1, 2026.

Notes and Clarifications

- All areas are balanced and meet Toastmasters requirements.
- Any future club losses or gains will not impact the required minimum number of clubs per area.
- This new “OZARK” Division (Central Arkansas clubs) will not disrupt existing D-50 divisions or leadership roles. This structure ensures clarity, leadership focus, and minimal disruption.
- All areas – both existing and new, meet Toastmasters requirements for the number of clubs per area.
- The current structure is built with flexibility. Any future gains or losses will not have a negative impact.

- Provides a clean structure for incoming clubs
- Positions District 50 for long-term success
